Justice of a Generous God

James 2:1-13

Who are we? Image bearers of a generous God

Favoritism = giving preference to one person or group over others.

Discrimination = unfair treatment of one person or group of people

Justice stands against both of those = equitable or fair treatment.

Image bearing v. 1

Our Heart Revealed v. 2-11

Favoritism hidden in the heart

God's heart revealed v. 5, 12-13

God is not partial

God knows what it is to be discriminated against

God is just

Justice of a generous God – Bearing His image well.
